Yellow Ribbon Fund Announces \$25K Donation from Go Energistics to House the Family of an Injured Service Member for an Entire Year

March 14, 2018, Bethesda, Md. – The Yellow Ribbon Fund (YRF) is proud to announce their new partnership with Go Energistics (GoE), a Dallas-based, Service Disabled Veteran Owned Small Business (SDVOSB) specializing in planning and building solutions for healthcare systems. Go Energistics is a values-based organization composed of primarily service-disabled veterans and veterans that have personally experienced or been impacted by service injuries. Their most recent donation will enable YRF to place a military family in a fully-furnished apartment less than one mile from Walter Reed National Military Medical Center in Bethesda, Maryland. Having their families close by during rehabilitation is crucial for the health and morale of these heroes as they receive treatments that last for months or even years.

“At Go Energistics, we believe that one of the greatest privileges we have is to serve those who serve us.” says CEO and Founder Adam Shepherd, a combat veteran who served over 30 years in the U.S. Army himself, “Providing a comfortable home away from home for a military family in a crisis situation is a way for us to give back and recognize not only the sacrifices these heroes have made but also the sacrifices their families have made as well.”

The Yellow Ribbon Fund assists injured service members and their families while they recuperate at Walter Reed National Military Medical Center and Fort Belvoir Community Hospital, and after they return home. Assistance includes free rental cars, hotel and apartment stays, support for family caregivers, and family-friendly events and outings that provide mental health breaks, nurture relationships under stress, and build confidence for those recovering from devastating injuries.
