## Yellow Ribbon Fund Partners with Artist William Quigley for Event Recognizing Military Caregivers

*Quigley to Auction Painting at Yellow Ribbon Fund's Duty & Devotion Event, Donating a Portion of the Profits to the YRF Mission*

Renowned artist William Quigley will sell his original painting "History" by auction at a private event hosted by Yellow Ribbon Fund (YRF) on February 21. Quigley will donate fifty percent of the proceeds to the nonprofit, supporting wounded, ill, and injured service members and their families. The event is part of Yellow Ribbon Fund's "Duty & Devotion" campaign, which recognizes the caregivers --'hidden heroes'-- that support recovering service members and celebrates their inspiring relationships.

His artwork has been featured in galleries and museums across the globe, including New York, Miami, Germany, India, and Spain. In 2007, Quigley was named Visual Artist of the Year by VH1 for his impact as both an artist and philanthropist.
